

DURATION OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR

- The First World War lasted from 1914 to 1918. Most of the great world powers participated in it, grouped into two conflicting military alliances: the Allies (grouped around the Triple Entente) and the Central Powers



WARRING PARTIES OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR

The First World War was fought by two major alliances. At the beginning, the Entente powers consisted of Serbia, Montenegro, Russia, France, Great Britain and Japan. Before the war, the Central Powers consisted of Germany, Austria-Hungary and Italy



THE TRIGGER OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR

- The trigger of the First World War was the assassination of the Austro-Hungarian Archduke Franz Ferdinand and his wife Sofia in Sarajevo on June 28, 1914 by Gavrilo Princip.



NATALIA'S RAMONDA

- The delicate, pale purple flower with the name of Queen Natalija, which is used in Serbia to mark the Armistice Day in the First World War (11th November), is known for its incredible endurance and is nicknamed the „phoenix flower“!



ŽIVOJIN MIŠIĆ

- Živojin Mišić was a Serbian and Yugoslav Field Marshal . During his forty-year military service, he was a participant of the the First and Second Balkan Wars, the First World War. He was born on July 19, 1855. and he died on 20.1.1921



RETREAT OF THE SERBS THROUGH THE ALBANIAN GOLGOTHA

- The Albanian Golgotha is the established name for the retreat of the Serbian army and exiled civilians across the snow-covered mountains of Albania and Montenegro after the invasion of Serbia by the Central Powers in the winter of 1915/16. during the First World War. This retreat proceeded in several columns from the direction of Metohija towards the coast of the Adriatic Sea, where the Allied commands organized transport by ships and reception to security destinations
