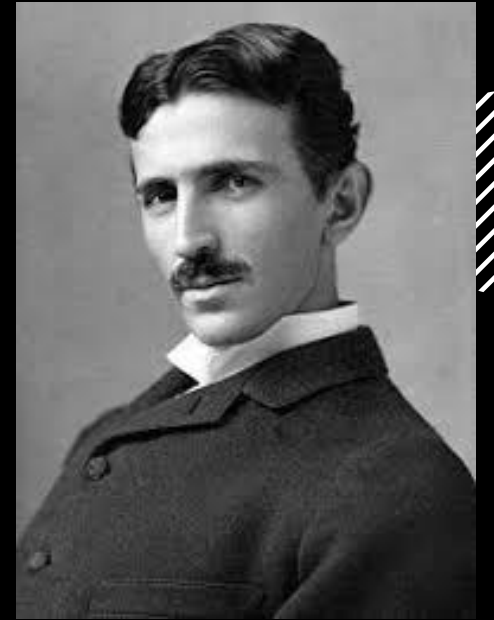

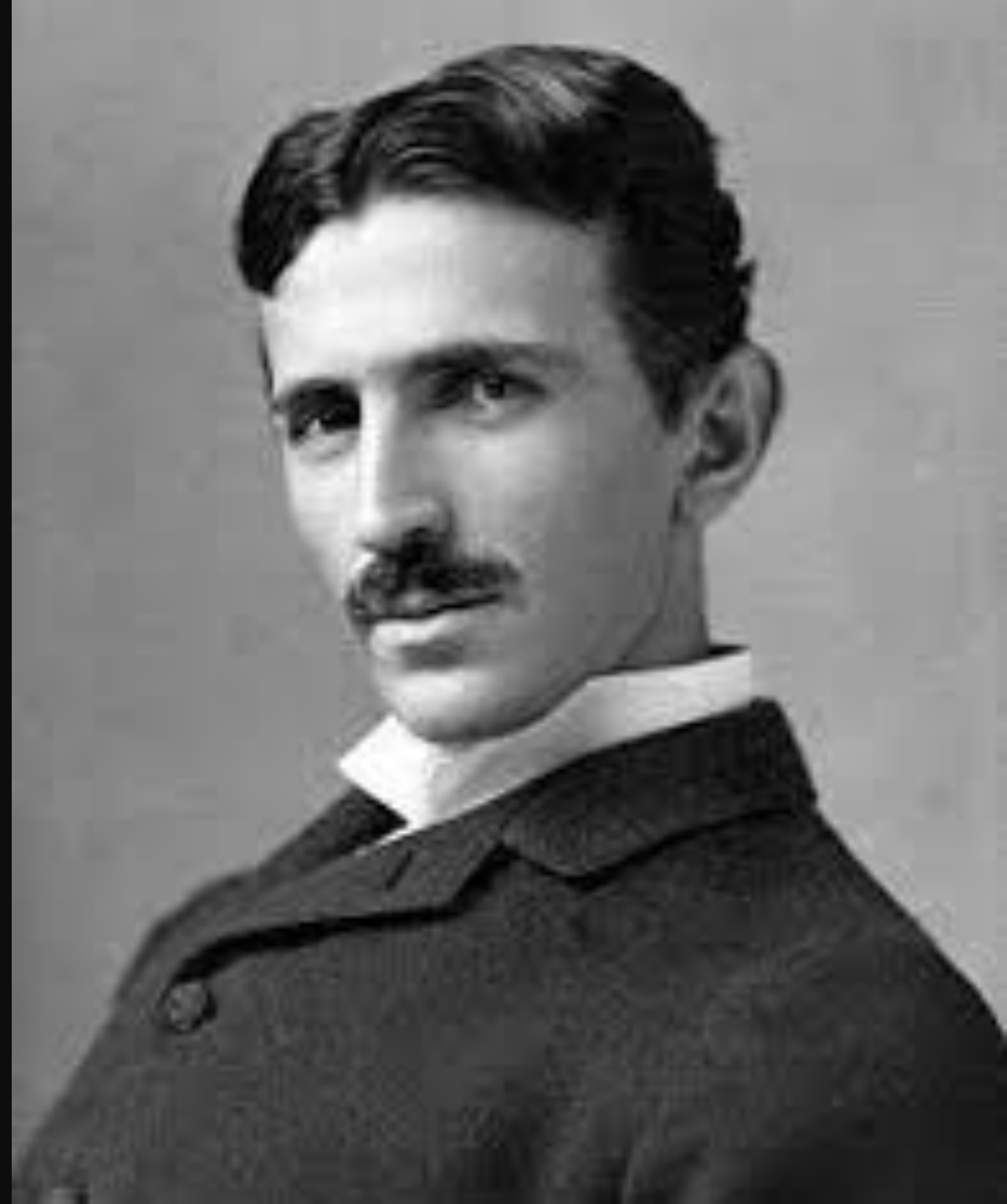

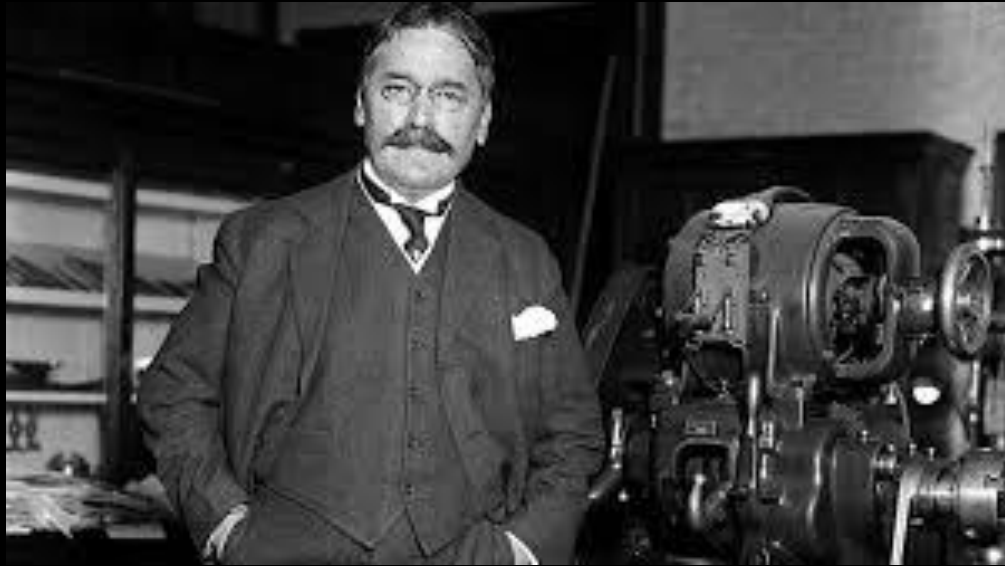


# Nikola Tesla

- **Nikola Tesla was a Serbian scientist and is one of the most important scientists for today's world. His most important invention is the alternating current which is used for powering almost everything.**

# Mihajlo Pupin

- Mihajlo Pupin was a Serbian scientist, inventor, professor at Columbia University, and won the Pulitzer Prize for his autobiography „From Immigrant to Inventor-Sa pašnjaka do naučenjaka". One of his most important inventions is „Pupin coil-Pupinov kalem" which solved the problem of a long distance telephone.



# Fun Facts about Serbia!

- Serbia is one of the world's leading **raspberry** exporters.



**Pule cheese** is the most expensive cheese in the world because it is produced exclusively at Serbia's Zasavica Special Nature Reserve. This rare cheese is made from the milk of Balkan donkeys which are endangered and native to Serbia and Montenegro.
